The Pastoral Council is a consultative body to the pastor. The purpose of the pastoral council is:

- To be attentive to the needs of the people of the Parish and work collaboratively with Parish clergy and staff to respond to those needs.
- To provide recommendations for parish priorities, directions, and policies through pastoral planning; and
- To promote communication and understanding among parish organizations and between the parish, the Diocese, and the universal church.

Council members serve three-year terms and may serve up to two consecutive terms.
